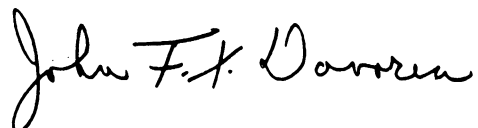

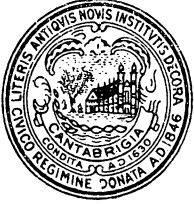

To perform and disseminate the result of research in the historical, cultural, literary, legal, scientific, medical, artistic, and musical heritage or any information or performance which promotes the general welfare of the Cape Verdean population. To establish and maintain reading rooms, libraries, and other facilities for the betterment of the Cape Verdean population. To promote the proper administration of civil and criminal justice, better housing. To do all things necessary, suitable, and proper for the accomplishment of any and all purposes, or the attainment of any of the objects, or the furtherance of any of the powers hereinbefore set forth, either alone or in concert with others, and to do every other act or acts, thing, or things, incidental or appurtenant to or growing out of or connected with the aforesaid business or powers or any part or parts thereof.

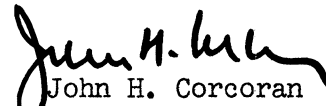
