represent, that they have made a large expenditure in
building said drain, and they ask, and petition that
a fair and just proportion of the cost shall be assessed
upon the abutters on said street, who have not contributed,
who may hereafter enter said drain, and the amount
so paid, or so much as may be properly due them, be paid
over to George C. Piper, who is authorized to receive it for
the benefit of those who have paid more than their fair
proportion of the expense in building said drain —
