

## An Ordinance

### Establishing the Salaries of Certain City Officers.

Be it ordained by the City Council of  
the City of Cambridge, as follows:-

Sec. 1. The officers of the City, hereinafter  
named, shall, from and after the first  
Monday of January in the year One  
Thousand eight hundred and sixty four,  
receive the following annual salaries, to  
be paid in equal quarterly payments,  
which shall be in full for all services  
rendered in their official capacity, viz:-

City Clerk, exclusive of fees established  
by law, fifteen hundred dollars.

Auditor of Accounts, five hundred  
dollars.

Superintendent of Streets<sup>and</sup> Chairs,  
twelve hundred dollars.

City Messenger, six hundred dollars.

Chief Engineer of the Fire Department,  
-ment, <sup>three</sup> ~~four~~ hundred dollars.

Sec. 2. All ordinances and parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
