That the Superintendent of Sts & Drains be and is hereby Ordered, to cause Curbstones to be set and the sidewalk properly graded, from a passageway in Gore Street to and around the corner of Fourth Street thence through Fourth Street to and around the corner of Winter Street, fronting the Estates of Messers Sherman, Leighton, Fessenden and Winchester, and that the expense of the same be assessed according to law,
