WHEREAS: The question of affordable housing is a recurring one and should be attacked from any and every direction; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City of Cambridge, Department of Community Development and the Cambridge Housing Authority form a partnership to look into the possibility of developing 2 or 3 floors of affordable housing, over the one story stores which line the north side of First Street and would be a fine base for the formation of a "neighborhood" when people could live and patronize the businesses such as grocery stores, cobblers, restaurants, shoe stores, etc. and report back to this City Council when the partnership has been formed.
