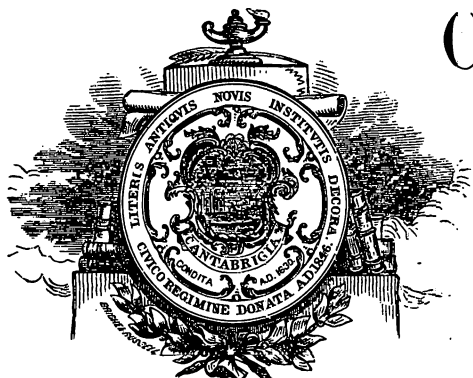




CITY OF CAMBRIDGE.

IN BOARD OF ALDERMEN,

Nov 2. 1874

WHEREAS: It is adjudged by this Board that the public necessity and convenience require that

Garden Street
between Wyeth St. and Walden St.
should be widened, and
~~should be~~ laid out as a public Street. Ordered that a strip of land *forty feet*
in width between *Wyeth and Walden Streets*

included between the *red* lines as shown on a plan drawn by

E. F. Bowker
dated August 1. 1873,

and now before this Board, be taken for public use and laid out as a public Street. *And that*
land shown on said plan as formerly used for part of said street, be discontinued.
Ordered that damages be allowed for the land so taken as aforesaid, as follows:
