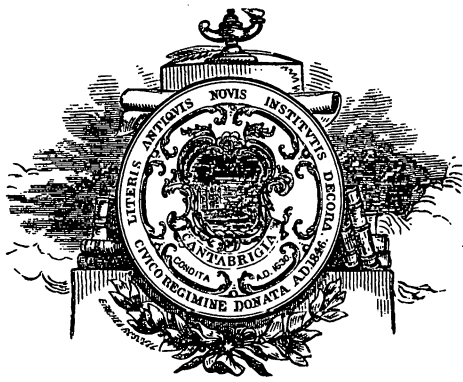




CITY OF CAMBRIDGE.

WHEREAS: It is adjudged by this Board that the public necessity and convenience require that

Patten Street,
from Sixth to Ninth street.

should be laid out as a public Street. Ordered that a strip of land
in width between

fifty feet
Sixth and Ninth Street

included between the *red* lines as shown on a plan drawn by *J. G. Chase*
Civil Engineer, dated Sept. 30. 1882

and now before this Board, be taken for public use and laid out as a public Street.

Ordered that *no* damages be allowed for the land so taken as aforesaid, *the*
several owners and abutters having agreed in writing
to waive all claims for such damages.
