To the Honorable, the City Council:

The Mid Cambridge Neighborhood Conservation District Commission wishes to express its opposition to the application for a curb cut at 329 Broadway and the paving of the side yard for use as parking.

While the Commission has no specific legal jurisdiction over the proposed change, we feel compelled to comment on the matter as we are charged, in a general way, "to improve the quality of [the City's] environment through the identification, conservation, and maintenance of neighborhoods, areas, sites and structures which constitute or reflect distinctive features ... of the City" and "to resist and restrain environmental influences adverse to this purpose" and "to promote the public welfare by making the City a more attractive and desirable place in which to live and work." The yard at 329 Broadway is one of the last areas of open green space remaining in Mid Cambridge. The paving of such a large yard in this densely built-up neighborhood is the type of environmental influence which the neighborhood and the Commission seek to prevent.

To lose this particular yard to a parking lot would deny the residents of Mid Cambridge of an amenity which makes the neighborhood an attractive and desirable place to live. We, therefore, ask that you deny the petitioner his request.
