Dear Sir:

In addition to the amount already provided we hereby request that the following sum of money be appropriated to Police A-1 Schedule, Permanent Employees:

Same to be provided by appropriation
from available funds in the Parking
Fund \$150,000.00

The above amount is required in order that we may meet our obligations to pay our Permanent Employees for the balance of the year.

The above amount of money was deducted from our A-1 Schedule request in the 1972 Annual Budget.

It states in the 1972 Annual Budget that the transfer is to be from Parking Meter Receipts for Traffic Control. This account is now known as the Parking Fund.

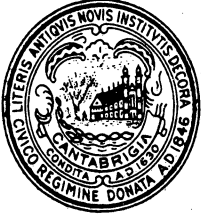
