Amended Order No. 10

IN CITY COUNCIL

March 31, 1986

COUNCILLOR DUEHAY

- ORDERED: That the City Manager, working closely with appropriate city departments, community groups and business associations, develop a program to deal with the problem of handing out handbills and posting them in the squares. Such a program might include:
1. Evaluating the feasibility of requiring those passing out handbills to register with a city department and to post a fee which would not be returned if the person involved did not clean up his materials discarded on the street;
 2. More aggressive follow-up by the police of handbills posted illegally on public and private property;
 3. Provision of community bulletin boards in each square on which notices and bills could be posted together with a mechanism to keep these bulletin boards updated.
