DATE: December 16, 1983

In accordance with Article VI of the Cambridge Industrial Development Financing Authority (IDFA) By-Laws, this memorandum shall serve as written notice that an official meeting of the Cambridge IDFA will be held on December 20, 1983 at 5 p.m. in the Ackermann Room of Cambridge City Hall.

The meeting is being held to review the IDFA application of FAR IV, a Cambridge based real estate firm, to use a \$809,889. industrial revenue bond to acquire and renovate an older industrial building at 60 Hamilton Street in Cambridgeport. The Tenant, Continuous Learning Corporation, manufactures and markets "innovative, problem oriented learning systems" for use with computers allowing self-paced instruction.

The IDFA will also review the application of H.J. Davis Development Corporation to use a \$12 million industrial revenue bond to renovate an existing building located on First Street in East Cambridge to accomodate new retail, office and research and development uses.
