Representatives of Cambridge Youth Hockey have recently met with city officials to discuss the possibility of the City of Cambridge serving as a conduit for the transfer of the Gore Street Rink from the M.D.C. to Cambridge Youth Hockey.

Over the years Cambridge has provided in-kind support to Cambridge Youth Hockey in their recruitment and programming efforts and has purchased limited amounts of ice time for them from the M.D.C. at the Gore Street Rink. The funds available for purchasing ice-time, however, have decreased sharply with the implementation of Proposition 2½ and no new funds can be anticipated in the foreseeable future.

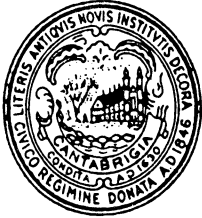
Notwithstanding these funding constraints, I would like to indicate the City's willingness to participate with Cambridge Youth Hockey in their negotiations with the M.D.C. to explore the possibility of a transfer of the Gore Street Rink. I have asked Paul Ryder, Director of the City's Recreation Department to serve as our liaison in this matter. He will be working closely with designees of Cambridge Youth Hockey as they pursue their interests with the M.D.C.

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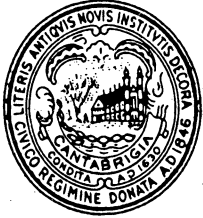

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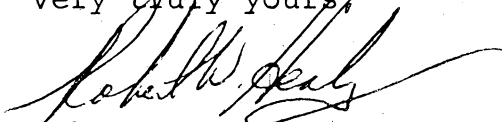

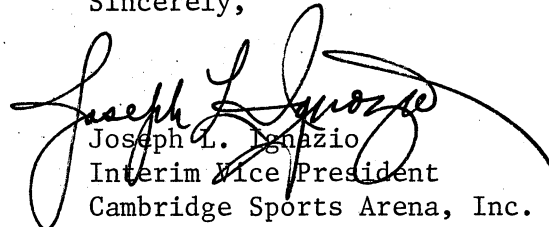
Dear Mr. Healy:
