I am hereby requesting the appropriation of a grant from the U.S. Department of Housing for \$330,000 to the Public Investment Fund Community Development Extraordinary Expenditures Account to provide funds to cover a portion of the cost of rehabilitating 11 rental units at 72 Elm Street and 210 Otis Street. Just-A-Start Corporation has used funds from the Affordable Housing Trust Fund to leverage these funds from the State HOME Program in its continuing effort to provide decent affordable housing to low-income residents of the City.
