To The Honorable, The City Council:

Attached is an order requesting the transfer of \$1,050,000 from the Employee Benefits Salaries and Wages Account to the Public Investment Fund Extraordinary Expenditure Account to provide additional funds needed to finance the CRLS and Systemwide Air Quality Project. Funds will be used to implement the recommendations of an environmental survey and analysis performed by Environmental Health Engineering, Inc.

The first phase of this project, which was funded in the FY89 Capital Budget in the amount of \$100,000, identified the needs to be addressed in the second phase. The primary focus of this phase at CRLS is maintenance work on the HVAC System, installation of new units as needed, removal of the greenhouse structure over the front entrance of CRLS, removal of rugs in classrooms, installation of tile and the design and installation of corridor ventilation in the Rindge Building. Elementary school work will focus on examining the mechanical ventilation systems and making repairs as needed.
