**ORDERED:**

That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to:

1. That a program designated as the "Cambridge Environmental Youth Employment Program" be established, effective July 1, 1974 and to terminate on August 31, 1974.

2. That any Cambridge youth between the ages of 17-21 be eligible to apply for acceptance into the program.

3. That the City Manager assume direct responsibility to develop the necessary administrative mechanisms.

4. That particular attention be paid to developing high quality supervision so that the work experience will be of benefit to the employees and to the City.

5. That the program concentrate on improving the environment through painting, landscaping, clean-up and related maintenance activities on City property, parks and recreation areas.


6. That the participants in the program be paid at a weekly salary rate that is not less than \$100 based on a forty (40) hour week.

7. That the sum of \$120,000 be appropriated and applied to the 1974-1975 tax rate or that the same amount be transferred from the Department of Public Works Temporary A-2 account to be expended for youth employment, supervision, materials, tools and supplies.
