WHEREAS:

Two of these youths had been escapees from the Bridgewater State Hospital since Thanksgiving Day, and

WHEREAS:

These same two youths, prior to their arrest, had held up a Cumberland Farms store at gunpoint, taking some two hundred dollars, and

WHEREAS:

This arrest was the result of aggressive police work by many Cambridge and Boston officers especially Cambridge Police Officers Thomas Tosi and Jean Sanchez, who spotted a suspicious Chevrolet van at Albany Street off Massachusetts Avenue, and

WHEREAS:

Officers Tosi and Sanchez pursued the speeding vehicle through Kenmore Square and onto Brookline Street and finally stopped said vehicle with assistance from the Boston Police, now therefore be it

That this City Council go on record congratulating Officers Thomas Tosi and Juan Sanchez for their alertness in spotting this suspicious vehicle and its occupants, and be it further
