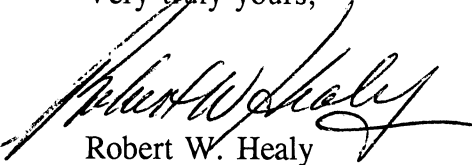

To The Honorable, The City Council:

I am hereby requesting the appropriation of \$1,334,864.00 in the Grant Fund of the Department of Human Services Salary and Wages Account (\$116,440.00) and Other Ordinary Maintenance Account (\$1,218,424.00) from the Massachusetts Executive Office of the Communities and Development Office of Fuel Assistance. The Cambridge/Somerville Low Income Heating Assistance Program (LIHEAP) is operated by the Department of Human Services which serves 3,500 clients in both cities including 1,400 Cambridge residents. Benefit levels for FY95 will range from \$75.00 to \$420.00 per client depending on the level of income and household characteristics. Funding for the program is provided by the Federal Government through HUD and passed through the Massachusetts EOCD.
