An Ordinance
To provide for the appointment of a
Superintendent of Public Schools.

Be it ordained by the City Council
of the City of Cambridge, as follows:—

Sec. 1. The School Committee shall
annually appoint a Superintendent of
Public Schools, who, under the
direction and control of said Committee
shall have the care and supervision
of the Schools, and whose duties shall
be defined by said Committee.

Sec. 2. Said Superintendent shall
receive an annual salary of
Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars,
payable in equal quarterly payments.

Sec. 3. This Ordinance shall
take effect on and after the
