AN ORDER CONCERNING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 1975

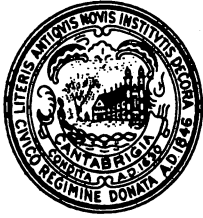

To the Honorable, the City Council:

The attached appropriation order, in the amount of \$48,117.16, has been requested by the Library Director based upon a grant from the state government for "state aid to free public libraries". Of this amount, \$12,500.00 will be used to complete the Central Square Branch Library. The remainder, \$35,617.17, will be added to the Library's salaries and wages appropriation to offset a part of the tax-supported portion of the Library's 1975-76 budget.
