Lindsay Communications, Inc., a Massachusetts corporation, has applied to the Department of Public Utilities for permission to resell mobile radio utility services. The Company proposes to offer cellular services for roadway emergency assistance service.

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The Department of Public Utilities will conduct a public hearing on the above matter at its hearing room, #1210 Leverett Saltonstall Building, 100 Cambridge Street, Boston, Massachusetts on Monday, June 21, 1993 at 10:00 A.M.

Application of Lindsay Communications, Inc. under the provisions of Chapter 159 of the General Laws as amended, for a certificate as a Radio Utility, for the resale of a Mobile Radio Utility System for compensation within the Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

The petitioner, Lindsay Communications, Inc., is required to give notice of said hearing by publication hereof once at least thirty (30) days prior to said date in the Fitchburg-Leominster Sentinel and Enterprise and the Boston Herald, and to serve a copy hereof at least thirty (30) days prior to said date on all parties on the attached Radio Common Carrier and Cellular companies lists.

Pursuant to 220 CMR 1.03(1), any person who desires to participate in this proceeding shall file a written petition for leave to intervene or to participate in the proceeding at least seven (7) days prior to the date for hearing.

The petitioner is also required to make return of service and publication at the time of the hearing.
