- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to prepare for presentation, a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution on behalf of the entire City Council.

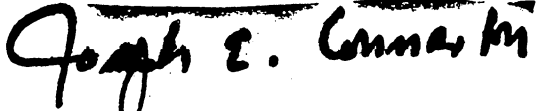
