- WHEREAS: It has come to the attention of this City Council that George Doherty, a life long Cambridge resident and career City employee will soon retire; and
- WHEREAS: George first entered the service of the City of Cambridge in 1944 and most of his forty years of service have been devoted to developing and implementing recreational programs for senior citizens, first as a member of the old Recreation Department and more recently with the Council on Aging, positions from which he has made an enviable reputation as an organizer of City-wide parties for the elderly in order that they may truly enjoy major holidays, such as Thanksgiving and Christmas; and
- WHEREAS: George was assisted in these efforts by his friend and long time colleague Frank Murphy, who together planned and conducted over three hundred trips for elder citizens; and
- WHEREAS: George has been active in civic and religious affairs in Cambridge, working for many years at the regular Bingo games at Saint John's Church in North Cambridge, as well as for the North Cambridge Veteran's Post #7353, and also served as President of the local office of American Federal, State, County and Municipal Employees Union; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its deep appreciation and gratitude to George Doherty for his total dedication to both the youth and elderly of this City through his forty-year career; and be it further
- RESOLVED: that the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to George on behalf of the entire City Council, with every good wish for much health and happiness in the years ahead.
