ORDERED:

That the following Resolution be adopted:

WHEREAS: The Title I Program in Cambridge is an outstanding feature of the Cambridge Public School system, a program recognized at the state and federal level, and,

WHEREAS: It has been cut for the next year by \$207,000 due to factors beyond the School Committee's control, such as the Gramm-Rudman bill, and,

WHEREAS: One thousand citizens of Cambridge have already put their names on a petition supporting restoration of those funds, and the Council of Children of the Office of Children has acted unanimously supporting same,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: That this School Committee respectfully request and urge that the Cambridge City Council allocate an additional \$207,000 to the Cambridge School Department for the express purpose of maintaining the Cambridge Title I Program at its current level of funding.

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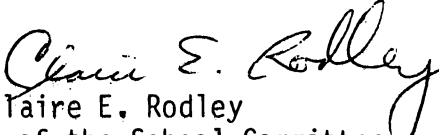
