In Board of ~~Aldermen~~, June 5th, 1860.

Ordered, Whereas it appears by the City Records, under date of Aug. 17, 1859, that "the matter of the grading of the sidewalks in front of the estate of George W. Hayes, on North Avenue, and the replacing of his wall by a fence, was taken from the table, and it was ordered, that the whole subject be referred to the Mayor, as a Surveyor of Highways, with full power," and whereas it appears by said Records, under date of Aug. 24, 1859, that "the Mayor reported that he had agreed with Geo. W. Hayes that the City should grade the sidewalks in front of his estate on North Avenue, replace the present stone wall by a picket fence, and slope the bank on the inside of the fence, the work to be done during the coming year, - which Report was accepted".

Ordered, That the Superintendent of Streets be authorized and instructed to cause the work mentioned in the agreement above recited, to be performed.
