

In the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty three.

An Ordinance

Relating to the Salary of the City Marshal.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Cambridge, as follows;— 1. The salary of the City Marshal shall be ~~Four~~ ^{Five} hundred ~~and fifty~~ dollars per annum, payable quarterly, which shall be in full for all his services; and all fees for warrants, and other services received by him, shall be paid into the City Treasury.

2. All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, inconsistent with the foregoing, are hereby repealed.
