

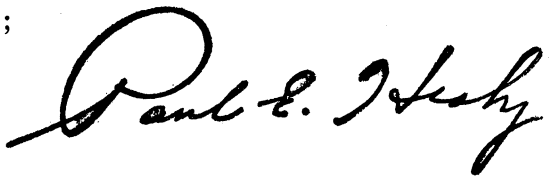

- WHEREAS: Life came to a close for Mary Parkman Peabody on February 6, 1981 ending a career which had been devoted to the service of her fellowmen; and
- WHEREAS: Mary Parkman Peabody, the widow of Rt. Reverend Malcolm E. Peabody of the Episcopal Church, was a life-long crusader for human rights who took an active roll in the civil rights and antiwar activity in the 1960-1970 era; and
- WHEREAS: Mary Parkman Peabody in March of 1964 at the age of seventy-two years was arrested and jailed in St. Augustine, Florida for her participation in a demonstration to end segregation at a motel complex; and
- WHEREAS: In the passing of Mary Parkman Peabody, the City of Cambridge and the Commonwealth of Massachusetts lost a conscientious, dedicated citizen who was inspired by family tradition and moved by her desire to improve the life of all who were blessed by her friendship; therefore be it
- RESOLVED: By the members of the Cambridge City Council in meeting assembled this ninth day of March, 1981, that we do hereby express our sorrow at the passing of Mary Parkman Peabody and acknowledging the great contributions of her public service, extend to her family, our most sincere condolences; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution be prepared and presented to her family.
