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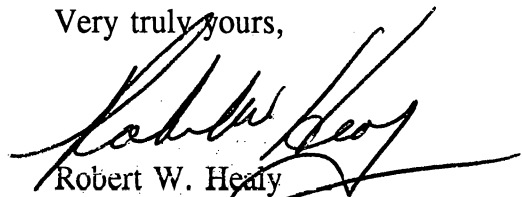

To The Honorable, The City Council:

I am hereby requesting the appropriation of an additional \$48,810.00 in Community Development Block Grant funds to the Public Investment Fund Community Development Extraordinary Expenditures Account to provide funds for new affordable housing developments for low and moderate income residents of the City. The City Council appropriated Block Grant funds in the amount of \$2,060,295.00 in the original FY96 Capital Budget. This estimate was necessary because HUD does not inform the City of its final entitlement until after the Community Development budget has been developed and approved by the City Council.
