- WHEREAS: It has come to the attention of this City Council that Charles R. Lavery, Jr., Chairman of the Board of Assessors, has resigned effective November 23, 1979; and
- WHEREAS: Mr. Lavery will assume the position of Chief Appraiser, New England Region for the General Services Administration; and
- WHEREAS: Mr. Lavery was first appointed to the Board of Assessors in 1967 and has served with distinction, as Chairman during the years 1968, 1970, 1973, 1975, 1977 and 1979; and
- WHEREAS: Mr. Lavery served as a member of the Board of Zoning Appeal during the 1966-1967 term; and
- WHEREAS: Mr. Lavery is a Certified Appraiser, a Certified Massachusetts Assessor and a Certified Assessment Evaluator, all of which typifies this man's outstanding professional and academic ability; and
- WHEREAS: Mr. Lavery served as President of the Massachusetts Association of Assessors during the 1977-1978 term, as President of the Middlesex County Assessors Association in 1976, as President of the Cambridge Economy Club in 1978 and as Vice President of the Cambridge Chamber of Commerce from 1976 to 1978; and
- WHEREAS: Through Mr. Lavery's leadership, our city has benefited by the development of an automated equalization program to attain and maintain fair market values as well as assessment policies which stimulate economic development and expansion; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending our deep appreciation and gratitude to Charles R. Lavery, Jr. as he assumes his new duties and to wish him well in all his future endeavors; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Mr. Lavery on behalf of the entire City Council.
