WHEREAS: It was further represented by a neighborhood resident that many calls have been made to an undetermined city department, now therefore be it

ORDERED: That it is requested that a determination be made as to the annual maintenance performed at said play area and as to the repair/replacement schedule for the tot lot; and be it further

ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to report back to this City Council on this matter as soon as possible.

Adopted by the affirmative vote of nine members.

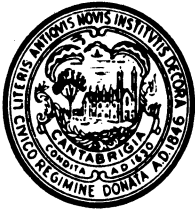

To the Honorable, the City Council:

In response to Awaiting Report #39 regarding the Corporal McTiernan Tot Lot, please be advised that emergency calls to the Department of Public Works (DPW) regarding broken glass, or any objects that would cause harm to individuals, are taken care of immediately after receipt.

The Corporal McTiernan Tot Lot is maintained by private contract. The Tot Lot is cleaned each Monday, Wednesday and Friday, from April through December. In addition, the Parks and Forestry Division inspects the park during the week. During a routine inspection, the broken glass in the sandbox area - the incident mentioned in the Council Order - was discovered and immediately cleaned up.

The DPW inspects parks between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. Upon learning that a group of individuals congregate at this location in the evenings to drink beer and break bottles, I have instructed the Police Department to pay particular attention to this area after dark.
