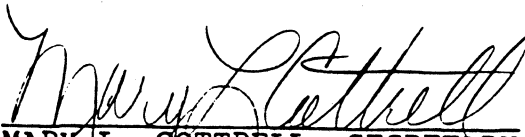
TRANSPORTATION OF PROPERTY

Investigation by the Department on its own motion as to the manner and degree to which the Department should regulate the transportation of property by motor carrier consistent with the provisions of G.L. c. 159B.

Upon the aforementioned investigation, the Department of Public Utilities will conduct a public hearing on Wednesday, May 6, 1987 at 10:00 a.m. at the Department's Office at 100 Cambridge Street, 12th Floor, Boston, Massachusetts 02202 to receive public comments on the manner in which the Department should regulate the transportation of property by motor carrier. The Department specifically solicits comments regarding the manner by which competitive market forces can or should be used and relied on in meeting existing statutory requirements. Comments regarding differences in the regulatory framework that may be appropriate for different segments of the industry, i.e., towings, movers, general commodities, etc., are also solicited. Proposals

suggesting ways in which the Department's regulations should be changed may also be included. The Department requests that, where possible, written comments be submitted to the Secretary of the Department at the above address at least seven days before the public hearing.
