

# City of Cambridge.

In Board of Aldermen, Nov. 26. 1862.

Resolved,

That the public convenience and necessity require that a private street, called "Eleople Avenue" be laid out as a public highway, from Broadway to Cambridge Street.

Therefore Ordered, That said street be and the same is hereby laid out and established as a public highway, by the name of Eleople Avenue, and forty feet in width, from Broadway to Cambridge Street, as the same is delineated on a Plan drawn by Alex. Wadsworth, dated June 2<sup>d</sup>. 1841, and now before this Board.

And, Whereas it is adjudged that no damage is sustained by any of the owners of the land over which said street is laid, by reason of the laying out of the same, it is

Ordered, That no damages be allowed to any person.
