On this evening's City Council agenda, you have a report from the City Manager regarding cost-of-living adjustments for City retirees. With your approval of the State enabling legislation, the Cambridge Retirement Board, which has already voted to accept this Act, would be able to grant cost-of-living adjustments to Cambridge retirees. I urge your acceptance of the provision of this Act, Chapter 17 of the Acts of 1997.
