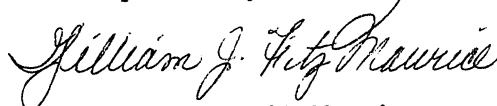
Dear Mr. Corcoran:

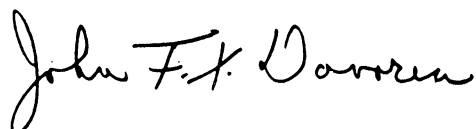

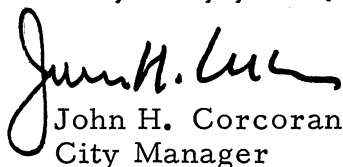
