IN THE YEAR ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINETY-FOUR

AN ACT

AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF CAMBRIDGE TO USE CERTAIN
PARK LAND TO CONSTRUCT AN EASTERN CAMBRIDGE YOUTH
CENTER

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. The City of Cambridge is hereby authorized to use for the erection of an Eastern Cambridge Youth Center, and for other related Youth Center activities or all purposes incidental thereto, the following described premises now owned and held by said City for park, playground or recreational purposes.

Beginning at a point on the southeasterly side line of Willow Street, said point being four hundred twenty-two and 56/100 (422.56) feet southwesterly from the point of curve of eight (8.0) foot radius at the southeasterly corner of Cambridge Street and Willow Street;

Thence, turning and running in a southeasterly direction one hundred forty-three and 40/100 (143.40) feet;

Thence, turning and running in a southwesterly direction one hundred fifty-four and 50/100 (154.50) feet;

Thence, turning and running in a northwesterly direction one hundred forty-three and 40/100 (143.40) feet to the southeasterly side line of Willow Street;

Thence, turning and running a northeasterly direction along the southeasterly side line of Willow Street, one hundred fifty-four and 50/100 (154.50) feet to the point of beginning.

The above described parcel, containing an area of 22,155 square feet, is shown on a Plan entitled "Plan of Land for Eastern Cambridge Youth Center in Cambridge, Mass." drawn by Wendell H. Mason, Professional Land Surveyor, dated August 29, 1994.

SECTION 2. This act shall take full effect upon its acceptance by vote of the City Council of said City, but not otherwise.

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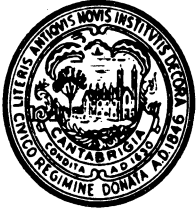
