- WHEREAS: Captain Michael J. Mahoney has been awarded the Role of Merit for his actions on Tuesday, October 20, 1998; and
- WHEREAS: On this day, while off duty, Captain Mahoney of Engine Company 2 witnessed a nine year old boy struck by a motor vehicle on Huron Avenue in Cambridge; and
- WHEREAS: Captain Mahoney immediately took steps to aid the youngster as well as secure the safety of the accident scene, assessing the patient and treating his injuries which included a compound leg fracture, while calming and reassuring the frightened youth until the EMS units arrived on the scene; and
- WHEREAS: Through his compassion and presence of mind, Captain Mahoney was able to minimize the danger faced by the injured youngster as well as that of motorists and pedestrians nearby; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That the Cambridge City Council hereby express its sincere gratitude to Captain Michael J. Mahoney for his selfless act, hoping that others will follow his fine example; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to prepare a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to be present to Captain Michael J. Mahoney on behalf on the entire City Council.

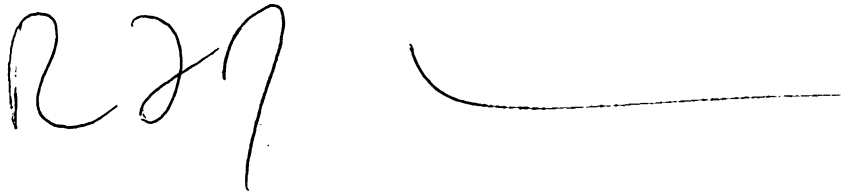
