February 13, 1989

(FOR THE CAMBRIDGE COMMITTEE ON HUMAN NEEDS)

- WHEREAS: Tens of millions of Americans rely on Social Security and Medicare; and
- WHEREAS: These Americans have paid into the Social Security System for many years; and
- WHEREAS: There will be no end to attacks on Social Security until it is removed from the budget and political process; and
- WHEREAS: Adequate and affordable health care is not being provided under Medicare; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record demanding that every commitment to Americans who qualify for Social Security and Medicare be kept; that Medicare be expanded to cover long-term catastrophic health care expenses while maintaining the concept of "social" insurance financing; and that fair Social Security benefits must be restored to all Americans born in the "Notch Years" after 1916; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That this City Council urge the Congress of the United States to take no action, such as limiting or abolishing annual COLAs or expanding taxation of Social Security benefits which would be destructive to the Social Security and Medicare benefits which have been promised to our people.
