I am hereby requesting the appropriation of \$15,750.00 in the Grant Fund of the Department of Human Services Salaries & Wages Account (\$14,425.00), Other Ordinary Maintenance Account (\$1,250.00) and Travel and Training Account (\$75.00) from the Massachusetts Department of Health, Tobacco Control Program.
