

THE COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-two

AN ACT DIRECTING THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION TO ACQUIRE,
MAINTAIN AND PRESERVE CERTAIN LAND IN THE CITY OF CAMBRIDGE AND TOWN OF BELMONT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court
assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. The metropolitan district commission is hereby authorized and directed to acquire by eminent domain under the provisions of chapter seventy-nine of the General Laws, or by purchase, gift or otherwise, and thereafter develop and maintain for park and recreation purposes certain land in the city of Cambridge and the town of Belmont, bounded and described as follows:-

NORTHWESTERLY by land of owners unknown, Flanders Road as extended and other land of owners unknown by three courses 163.30 ft., 36.29 feet and 70.01 feet respectively;

SOUTHWESTERLY by land of owners unknown, shown as Land Court #14234, 349.65 ft.;

SOUTHERLY by land of owners unknown, shown as Land Court #5481, 281.81 ft.;

EASTERLY by Lot B as shown on a plan hereinafter referred to, 451.39 ft.;

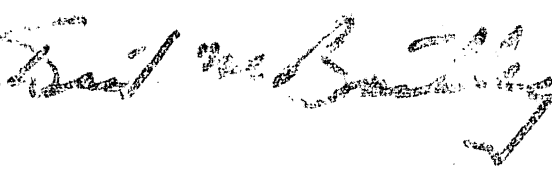
NORTHERLY by land now or formerly of the Boston & Maine Railroad, 193.06 ft.;

Containing 155,259 square feet as shown on said plan. Said premises are shown as Lot A on a Plan by Fred R. Joyce, Surveyor, dated September 18, 1968, recorded in Middlesex South District Registry of Deeds, Book 11578, page 176,178. The above described lot contains 56628 square feet pond area, and 98631 square feet land area.

SECTION 2. Said commission may make application on behalf of the commonwealth for, and use such federal funds or assistance, or both, as may be available for the planning and development of the said area.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
