- WHEREAS: Upon being contacted by Mr. Spangler, Marco Ciampa, President of East Cambridge Little League. Mr. Ciampa took possession of these bats which will now be used by East Cambridge Little League teams; and
- WHEREAS: East Cambridge Little League is very happy that ACX has provided these bats and appreciates the efforts of both Ken Lazarus and Ron Spangler for making these bats available; now therefore be it
