IN CITY COUNCIL

November 17, 1975

WHEREAS:

This City Council was shocked and saddened to hear of the sudden death of Police Chief Francis A. Pisani which occurred on Tuesday, November 4, 1975, and

WHEREAS:

Chief Pisani was a most dedicated and sincere police officer, always striving for perfection in whatever task he may have been given to perform, and

WHEREAS:

Chief Francis A. Pisani was first appointed to the department as a permanent officer on May 19, 1958, promoted to Sergeant on January 2, 1966, promoted to Lieutenant on August 31, 1969, promoted to Captain on September 9, 1973 and finally topping his professional police career by being appointed Acting Chief of Police on January 6, 1975, and

WHEREAS:

Chief Pisani's first assignment, upon being appointed Chief, was the implementation of the International Association of Chiefs of Police Report relative to the operation, reorganization and staffing of the Police Department, and

WHEREAS:

The tireless efforts and outstanding qualities of Chief Pisani were the major factors in successfully initiating the recommendations of the IACP Report, as well as implementing some of his own innovative ideas, and

WHEREAS:

Chief Pisani was a former fellow at Harvard University, School of Criminal Justice and only last year attended the Federal Bureau of Investigation Training Academy, and

WHEREAS:

Over the years, Chief Pisani became admired and loved by this community, truly being a man for all seasons, now therefore be it

RESOLVED:

That this City Council go on record extending our sincere sorrow to the wife and family of Chief Pisani at their great loss, and be it further
