ORDERED:-

That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to confer with the appropriate City department heads and the appropriate officials of the Boston and Maine Railroad with the view in mind to completely clean both sides of the railroad tracks from the junction of Massachusetts Avenue and the rail bed at the intersection of Cedar Street going in a northwesterly direction to the Arlington line, and that this "Clean-Up" project be one of a very thorough nature, which would also include the removal of any abandoned trucks and cars.

That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to confer with the appropriate department heads of the City and the appropriate officials of the Boston and Albany Division of the New York Central Railroad to do a similar clean-up program on the railroad tracks from Broadway to the Somerville line.
