
Dear Mayor:

I was appalled to learn of the proposed City Ordinance on permits required for condominium occupancy.

I have done considerable work in the condominium field, for developers as well as banks, and want to call to your attention that the proposed ordinance is, in my opinion as well as the opinion of every other attorney I have talked with, clearly unconstitutional.

I urge you to reconsider the proposed ordinance and consult competent legal counsel before any favorable action is taken on it, especially in view of the personal liability incurred under Chapter 258, Section 2 of the General Laws.
