in the year one thousand eight hundred and forty-eight.

An Ordinance,
establishing the salaries of certain City Officers.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City
of Cambridge, as follows:-

1. The Officers of the City, hereinafter named,
shall receive the following annual salaries, to be
paid in equal quarterly payments, which shall
be in full for all services rendered in their
official capacity, viz: -

City Treasurer, three hundred dollars.

City Clerk, exclusive of fees established by law,
_____ Seven hundred dollars.

Clerk of Common Council, one hundred dollars.

Board of Assessors, six hundred dollars.

Collector of Taxes, five hundred dollars.

City Marshal, four hundred and fifty dollars.

City Messenger, three hundred dollars.

Chief Engineer, one hundred dollars.

Four Assistant Engineers, twenty-five dollars each.

2. All Ordinances, or parts of Ordinances,
inconsistent with the foregoing, are hereby repealed.
