- WHEREAS: The education and programs for young children in pre-school and after-school settings are very important for those children and, in many cases, will very much influence their future success in school and in life; and
- WHEREAS: It is, therefore, important that teachers and day-care workers in pre-school and after-school workers be skilled, consistent, and energetic; and
- WHEREAS: To get such qualities, it is important that people working with young children be well-paid, at the same time recognizing that the programs must remain affordable; therefore be it
- ORDERED: That the City Manager, in his initial negotiations with day-care workers, do everything possible to meet the important goal of providing adequate and fair pay while keeping the programs affordable.
