- WHEREAS: On Thursday, November 18th, from 2:30 - 6:00 P.M. at the outpatient clinic of the Cambridge Hospital, free monovalent and bivalent Swine Flu shots will be administered, and
- WHEREAS: Many City of Cambridge employees come into contact with a number of people in the daily performance of their jobs, and
- WHEREAS: Many city employees, therefore; have an increased risk of becoming infected, now therefore be it
- ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to circulate a memorandum encouraging City of Cambridge employees to get a Swine Flu shot on Thursday.
