COUNCILLOR GRAHAM

WHEREAS: It has been suggested by the Superintendent of Schools and his top administrators that the cost of the food service program for students be increased by ten cents per meal; and

WHEREAS: Although this may be considered in the minds of these administrators as a small inconvenience to the parents of these children, it is in fact an unrealistic recommendation; and

WHEREAS: It should be the prime concern of our School administrators, the School Committee and the City Council to provide the best possible nutrition programs for the lowest possible cost to our school children; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record as being opposed to any budgetary recommendation by the Superintendent of Schools which would cause an increase in the food service program for our school children.
