In response to Awaiting Report Item No. 99-56, regarding a report on the new crosswalk signals that indicate the number of the seconds before pedestrians can cross, Traffic, Parking & Transportation Director Susan Clippinger reports the following:

The Department will be installing a countdown pedestrian traffic signal at the intersection of Prospect Street and Bishop Allen Drive during the month of April and will study the intersection for the effectiveness of the signal.

These signals countdown the time left remaining when the signal is in the "flashing don't walk" phase which means it lets a pedestrian know how much time they have left to complete their walk across the street.
