William H. McGinness first entered the employ of our city in 1923 working in the engineering section of the Assessing Department until 1942, at which time former City Manager John B. Atkinson asked him to serve as Purchasing Agent, a position Mr. McGinness held until 1947 when he was appointed Acting Superintendent of the Water Department, and

WHEREAS:

Having taken and topped the list of a competitive Civil Service examination for the permanent position of Superintendent, Mr. McGinness was appointed to that position on January 17, 1950 and has remained as our Superintendent for the past twenty-six (26) years, and

WHEREAS:

William H. McGinness served the City of Cambridge with total loyalty, integrity and true dedication, now therefore be it

That this City Council go on record extending our sincere gratitude to Mr. William H. McGinness as he approaches retirement from city service and to further extend to him our best wishes for the future, and be it further
