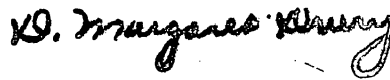

WHEREAS: Leo married Grace Shaughnessy here in Cambridge; and

WHEREAS: Leo was the youngest member of the House of Representatives when he was elected in 1936; and

WHEREAS: Leo represented Wards 4-5-6-7 of Cambridge; and

WHEREAS: Leo served under Governor Peabody as the Commissioner of Taxes; and

WHEREAS: In 1971 Leo went to serve on the staff of his lifelong friend and Speaker of the House of Representatives, Thomas "Tip" O'Neill; and

WHEREAS: Leo spent seventeen years as Tip's administrative assistant in Washington, DC; and

WHEREAS: During the Kennedy Presidency, Leo was appointed to the Department of the Interior in the Advanced Commission for the Cape Cod Seashore; and
