In Board of Aldermen, April 6 1870

The Joint Standing Committee on
Roads & Bridges
to which were referred the following named
petitions would respectfully Report

On the petition of Hosea Spencer
& others for the widening of Essex Street
from Main to Austin Streets, your Committee
recommend that the prayer of the petitioners
be granted, & a widening be made in accordance
with plans made by J. P. Chase City
Engineer Aug. 17th 1868 & herewith submitted,
with an additional widening of one foot upon
the Easterly side, not shown on said plans:
& they further recommend that immediate
notice be served upon the abutters, & all
persons interested, that this Board intends
to take a portion of their lands for the purpose
of said widening & to assess a part of the
expense of the same upon the estates benefited
thereby.

On the Petition of W. P. Pickett & others
for the extension of Clark Street from School

to Main Street; your committee recommend that the prayer of these petitioners be granted, & that a strip of unoccupied land thirty feet wide, laying between Main & School streets, opposite the end of Clark Street, be taken for that purpose, & that the same form of notice be issued to all parties interested as recommended in the case of Essex Street

On the petition of C. L. Jones & others for the acceptance of Valentine Street from Pearl to Brookline streets; your committee recommend that the prayer of the petitioners be granted when the abutments have complied with the usual conditions.

On the petition of Oliver Taylor et al for the acceptance of Cogswell Street; your committee would report that, no action is, at present, necessary, as the City Council of last year voted to accept the street on the usual conditions which have not yet been complied with by the abutments
